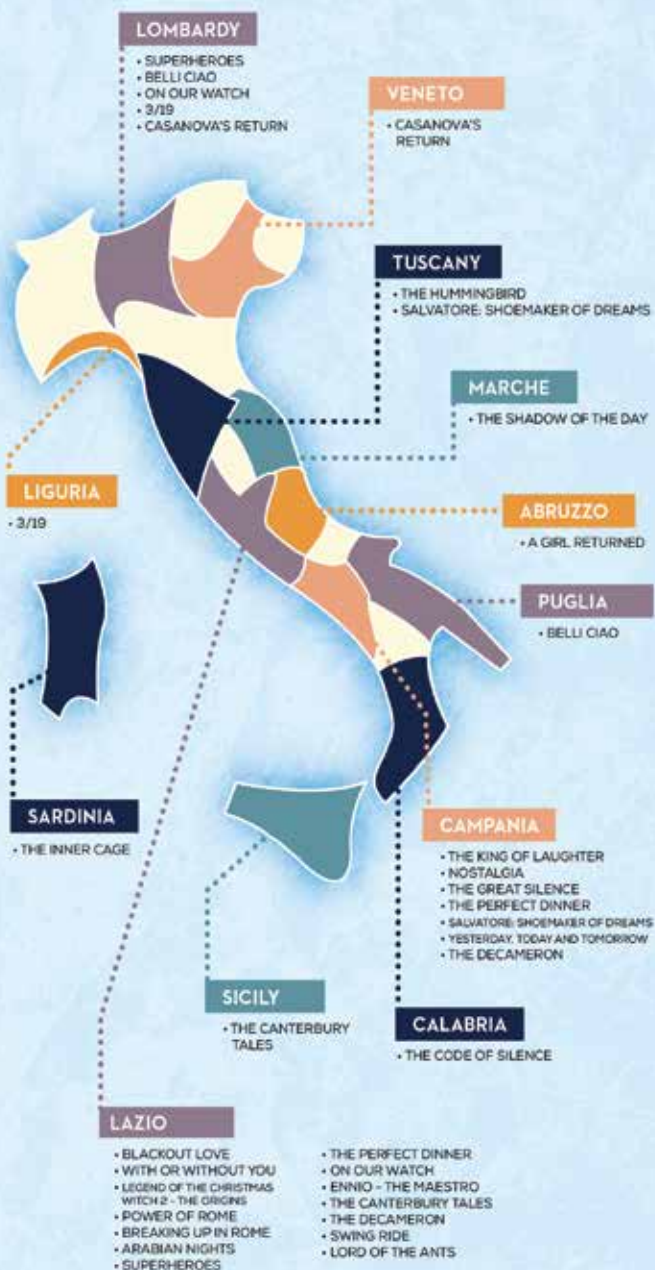


Serraiocco made her feature film debut in 2013, starring in *Salvo*, awarded Critics' Week Grand Prix at the Cannes Film Festival that year and for which she won the Italian Golden Globe for Best Actress and the "Guglielmo Biraghi" Nastro d'Argento Award for Best New Talent. From then, Serraiocco continued to work consistently on many critically acclaimed films including: *Cloro* (2015), directed by Lamberto Sanfelice; and 2017's *Worldly Girl (La Ragazza del Mondo)*, for which she won the "Premio Pasinetti" (the National Guild of Film Critics' Award) for Best Actress at the Venice Film Festival.

Serraiocco was chosen as a member of the jury at the 72nd annual Berlin International Film Festival (Shooting Stars award) in 2016, and as a member of the international jury at the Kiev Film Festival in 2019.

Sara Serraiocco is arriving directly from the Venice Film Festival to present two films at this year's festival: Special Presentation *Lord of the Ants*, and *Casanova's Return*, directed by Oscar-winning Gabriele Salvatores.

AUSTRALIAN PREMIERE

Starring and co-written by popular comic duo Pio and Amedeo, hit comedy *Belli Ciao* from Gennaro Nunziante (*Where am I Going?*, *IFF16*) delivers a lighthearted north versus south culture clash. Pio and Amedeo are inseparable friends until they finish high school, when they are faced with the fateful dilemma that grips young people of the South: give up everything and go north for work or stay home and build a better tomorrow. While the ambitious Pio decides to leave for Milan, Amedeo chooses to remain in their hometown, dividing his time between a health care shop and the town council, working with the Mayor to help prevent the exodus of the youth to the north. But to revive the local economy, a large investment is needed and due to an unpredictable twist of fate, the two friends meet again after years apart. By working towards a common goal, the pair rediscover their friendship and realise that home is not where you are, but who you are with.

Born in 1963, director, screenwriter, editor and actor Gennaro Nunziante is known for his four Checco Zalone films. YESTERDAY, TODAY AND TOMORROW

IERI, OGGI, DOMANI

Winner of the Best Foreign Language Film Oscar at the 1964 Academy Awards, *Yesterday, Today and Tomorrow* is a sparkingly original trilogy of risqué romantic comedies set in different parts of Italy, with Sophia Loren and Marcello Mastroianni starring in each story. The two play lovers in the three vignettes, reuniting on the screen after seven years. In Naples, poor but resourceful Adelina supports her husband by selling black market cigarettes. In Milan, wealthy Anna debates her preference for a Rolls Royce or her husband and is having an affair with poor Renzo, whose infatuation is tested by a near-tragedy. In Rome, prostitute Mara resists the advances of her neighbour's grandson, a priest who has fallen in love with her. This episode features the iconic scene: a provocative striptease by Loren for her client (played by Mastroianni). Witty and unforgettable, this gem from master filmmaker Vittorio de Sica (*Bicycle Thieves*, *Marriage Italian Style*) is picture-postcard beautiful and effortlessly hilarious.

DIRECTOR: VITTORIO DE SICA

Vittorio was a leading figure in the neorealist movement. Starting out as an actor, by the late 1920s he was successful in the Italian theatre and light comedy movies. Turning to directing in 1940, four of his films won Academy Awards: *Shoeshine* (1946) and *Bicycle Thieves* (1948) which won special Oscars before the foreign film category was established, plus *Yesterday, Today and Tomorrow* (1963) and *The Garden of the Finzi Continis* (1970) which won Best Foreign Language Film Oscar.

LORD OF THE ANTS

IL SIGNORE DELLE FORMICHE

AUSTRALIAN PREMIERE

Screening direct from Venice competition, the powerful new drama from Gianni Amelio (*Hammamet IFF20, Open Doors*) recounts the controversial trial of Aldo Braibanti, an intellectual whose relationship with a younger student caused a nationwide scandal. Rome, 1968. Soft-spoken playwright Braibanti (Luigi Lo Cascio, *The Ties IFF21*) is arrested on charges of 'plagiarism'; that he subjugated another person and led them morally astray. The charges - resting on a rarely cited Fascist-era law - are brought by the family of his partner Ettore (newcomer Leonardo Maltese) who, seeking to extract the younger man from Braibanti's influence, commits him to a psychiatric hospital. Braibanti elects to run his own defence, one where the very essence of his life is scrutinised: art, science, philosophy and sexuality. Meanwhile, the case receives national attention through the efforts of a local journalist (Elio Germano, *Hidden Away IFF 21*) whose empathetic reporting stokes community suspicion and the ire of his editor. Elegantly mounted and superbly performed, Amelio's impassioned film is a deeply affecting reminder of the conflicts that simmer just below the surface of 'civilised' society, as much now as ever.

DIRECTOR: GIANNI AMELIO

Gianni Amelio (born Magisano, Calabria, 1945) is a director and writer. At university in Messina, Amelio became interested in cinema, writing as film critic. In 1965 he moved to Rome and worked as an operator and assistant director for figures such as Liliana Cavani and Vittorio De Seta. His films include Academy Award nominee *Open Doors* (1991), Cannes Jury Prize Winner *The Stolen Children* (1993), *Lamerica* (1995), *The Keys to the House* (2005) and *Hammamet* (2020).

THE HUMMINGBIRD

IL COLIBRÌ

AUSTRALIAN PREMIERE

Direct from its World Premiere at the Toronto International Film Festival, this profoundly moving drama follows the life of Marco Carrera (Pierfrancesco Favino, also in *Nostalgia*) from childhood to adulthood and the myriad of relationships along the way. Featuring an all-star ensemble cast including Nanni Moretti (*Three Floors*), Kasia Smutniak (also in *3/19*) and Berenice Bejo, *The Hummingbird* follows a life of fatal coincidences, losses and absolute loves. Based on the strength of memories, the story flits from one period to another, from the early 1970s to the near future. Along his journey from a platonic love affair by the sea, to marrying a woman in Florence and starting a family, Marco receives the help of his psychoanalyst (Moretti), who teaches him how to welcome the most unexpected changes of direction. Bringing the international bestselling novel by Sandro Veronesi to the big screen, Archibugi's *The Hummingbird* delivers a story of the ancestral force of life and the struggle to resist what sometimes seems unsustainable, even with the powerful weapons of illusion, happiness and cheerfulness.

DIRECTOR: FRANCESCA ARCHIBUGI

Francesca Archibugi (born Rome, 1960) is an actress, director and writer. In the 1970s, she acted in a handful of films, but her work behind the camera flourished after she studied filmmaking at the Centro Sperimentale di Cinematografia Cinecittà. After directing short films in the early 1980s, she made her feature film debut with *Mignon Has Come to Stay* (1988), which won 5 David di Donatello awards. Her 1993 film *The Great Pumpkin* solidified her reputation as one of Italy's most important directors.

NOSTALGIA

AUSTRALIAN PREMIERE

The excellent Pierfrancesco Favino (*Padre nostro* IFF21, *The Traitor* IFF20) stars in suspenseful drama *Nostalgia*, a bittersweet exploration of the complexity of homecoming. After forty years spent in the Middle East and Africa, businessman Felice Lasco (Favino) returns to his hometown of Rione Sanità in Naples. Visiting his ageing mother, Teresa (Aurora Quattrocchi), he is upset to discover she has moved from his childhood home to a poorly maintained ground floor apartment. While he has forgotten how to speak the Neapolitan dialect, he feels that despite the years which have passed, everything is the same. Wandering his old neighbourhood's streets, he is caught up in memories of his past and criminal youth. Despite local priest Don Luigi's (Francesco Di Leva) advice to leave his past behind, he seeks out childhood friend Oreste (Tommaso Ragno), now a feared local mobster. Directed and co-written by Mario Martone, this atmospheric adaptation of Ermanno Rea's 2016 novel is an absorbing tale of regrets and a nostalgic love-letter to Naples.

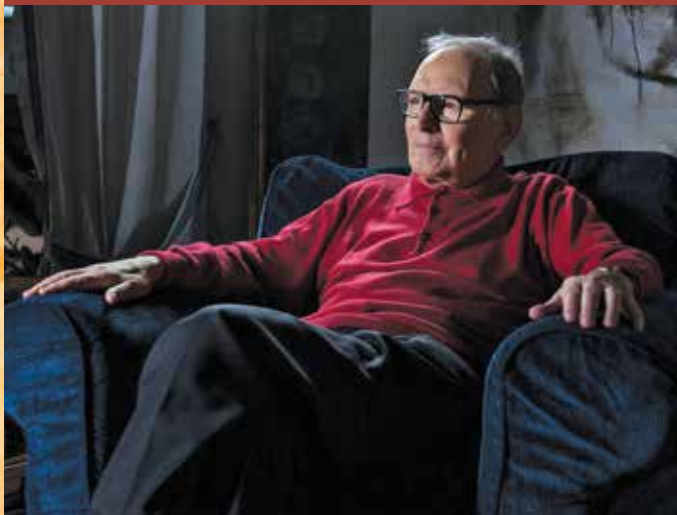

ENNIO - THE MAESTRO

ENNIO

From Oscar-winning director Giuseppe Tornatore (*Cinema Paradiso*, *Malena*), *Ennio - The Maestro* celebrates the life and legacy of the legendary Italian composer Ennio Morricone. Centred around an in-depth interview with Morricone recorded shortly before his death in 2020, aged 91 and conducted by Tornatore, the film forms a well-rounded portrait of the maestro by weaving together archival footage, music and testimonies from artists and directors, including Bernardo Bertolucci, Marco Bellocchio, Dario Argento, Quentin Tarantino, Bruce Springsteen and Hans Zimmer. Yet it also reveals the lesser-known side of Morricone, including his passion for the game of chess, which may have mysterious links with his music, and the origins of some of his music, like the howl of the coyote that inspired the theme of *The Good, the Bad and the Ugly*. From his early arrangements to his cinema debut with Sergio Leone, to his Academy Award-winning score for *The Hateful Eight* (2016), we delve into the life of the most prolific film composer of the 20th century, composer of over 500 unforgettable scores.

DIRECTOR: GIUSEPPE TORNATORE

Giuseppe Tornatore (born in Sicily, 1956) is a film director and screenwriter. Before becoming a filmmaker, he worked as an award-winning photographer and television documentary director. Tornatore earned international acclaim in 1988 with his second film *Cinema Paradiso*, which won an Oscar and a Golden Globe for Best Foreign Language Film in 1990. His other well-known works include *Malena* (2000), *The Legend of 1900* (1998) and *The Best Offer* (2013).

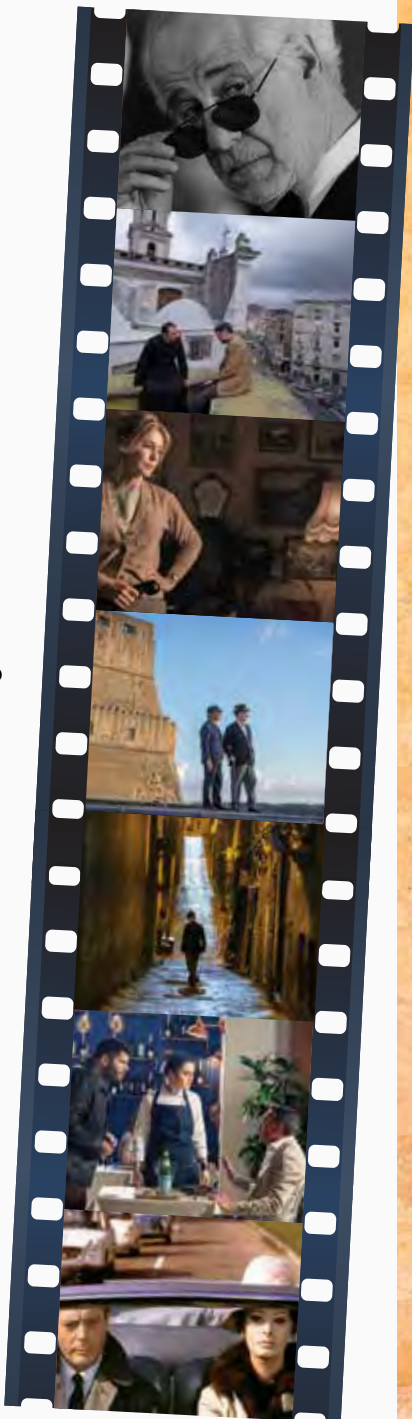

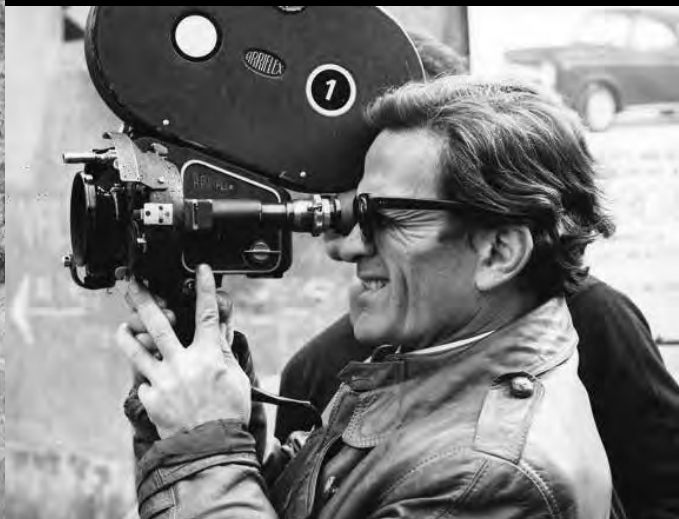

PIER PAOLO PASOLINI CENTENARY RETROSPECTIVE

In this retrospective celebrating the centenary of Pier Paolo Pasolini's birth, we present three of his iconic film adaptations of literary works: *The Canterbury Tales* on its 50th anniversary, *Arabian Nights* and *The Decameron*.

Born on the 5th of March 1922 in Bologna, Pier Paolo Pasolini was a controversial Italian motion-picture director, actor, poet, novelist and intellectual, noted for his socially critical, stylistically unorthodox films.

After a childhood spent in northeastern Italy, he attended the University of Bologna, studying art history and literature and was a published poet at 19. In the 1950s, he worked with Federico Fellini on the screenplays for *Nights of Cabiria* (1957) and *La dolce vita* (1960) and was nearly forty when he directed his first feature, *Accattone* (1961), cowritten with Sergio Citti.

After making his best-known film *The Gospel According to Saint Matthew* (1964), Pasolini's films alternated between scandalously erotic adaptations of classic literary texts, including *Oedipus Rex* (1967); *The Decameron* (1971); *The Canterbury Tales* (1972); *Arabian Nights* (1974), with his own more personal projects expressing his controversial views, notably *Teorema* (1968) and the notorious *Salò, or the 120 Days of Sodom* (1975).

He was murdered in mysterious circumstances on November 2, 1975, and his legacy remains contentious.

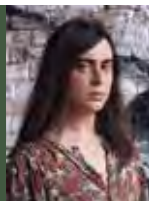

IL SILENZIO GRANDE

AUSTRALIAN PREMIERE

In 1960s Naples, Villa Primic, once a luxurious home, now a creaky mansion straight out of a ghost story. In a painful and reluctant decision, it has been put up for sale by Mrs Rose Primic (Margherita Buy, *Three Floors IFF21*) and the two heirs to the Primic's dilapidated fortune, Massimiliano (Emanuele Linfatti) and Adele (Antonia Fotaras). The only member of the family who is not at all happy with the decision is the head of the household, Valerio (Massimiliano Gallo, *The Hand of God*). He discovers that he has never really known his loved ones and, perhaps, not even himself, and grudgingly reaches the conclusion that living is not the same thing as being alive. In his third feature as a director, Alessandro Gassmann brings Maurizio De Giovanni's stage play of the same name to the big screen. Facing the inevitable changes and passing of time, *The Great Silence* is the story of the voices and silences of a chaotic family, marked by conflicts and misunderstandings.

THE INNER CAGE

Winner of the 2022 David di Donatello Awards for Best Original Screenplay and Best Actor, *The Inner Cage* is an affecting group character study set within the last remains of an abandoned prison. A 19th century prison, located in a remote and unspecified part of the Italian territory, is being decommissioned. As a result of bureaucratic holdups, transfers have been blocked and a dozen detainees and a few guards are left, waiting to be sent to new destinations. While they wait, a group of officers must remain on the premises to watch over the detainees, led by guard captain Gaetano (Toni Servillo, *The Great Beauty IFF13*), while the prisoners have their own self-appointed boss, influential mobster Carmine (Silvio Orlando, *The Ties IFF21*). As the rules that kept the guards and prisoners separate are loosened, new forms of relationships emerge among the remaining men. Backed by a strong ensemble cast, Leonardo Di Costanzo's evocative drama depicting the prison's inner workings is imbued with a suspenseful atmosphere and a theatrical tone.

After initially making documentaries, he made his first feature *The Interval* in 2012, which was presented at the Venice International Film Festival and won Best New Director at the David di Donatello Awards. His last film before *The Inner Cage* was *L'intrusa* in 2017.



THE KING OF LAUGHTER

QUI RIDO IO

AUSTRALIAN PREMIERE

Winner of Best Director and Best Screenplay at the 2022 Nasti d'Argento Awards, this extravagant biopic depicts the life of the 19th- and early-20th-century king of Neapolitan comedians, the great actor and playwright Eduardo Scarpetta, masterfully portrayed by Toni Servillo. Devoting his life to the theatre and achieving great success, Scarpetta created works that went on to become timeless classics, like *Miseria e Nobiltà*. Ever-present was his peculiar family, composed of his wife Rosa (Maria Nazionale), lovers and legitimate and illegitimate children. In 1904, at the height of his popularity, Scarpetta took a great risk: he staged a parody of *Il Figlio di Iorio*, a tragedy written by the greatest Italian poet of the day, Gabriele D'Annunzio. This parody became central to a memorable trial, the first ever lawsuit on copyright in Italy. Moving from the stage to behind the curtain, Mario Martone's (also directs *Nostalgia*) backstage drama *The King of Laughter* is a lavish biopic of the legendary Scarpetta, made with a clear love for the theatre.
